IRRV Annual Conference 2015 Telford 6th to 8th October 2015

SPONSORED TWO DAY DELEGATE PLACES FOR AUTHORITIES IN LANCASHIRE AND CHESHIRE



The IRRV Lancashire & Cheshire Association are pleased to announce that we have secured a number of sponsored two day delegate passes to this year's IRRV Annual Conference to be held at Telford from 6^{th} to 8^{th} October.

This development and educational opportunity is provided at little or no expense to local authorities.

These delegate passes provide access to the conference on 6th and 7th October, with the Association also providing **£100 towards the cost of overnight accommodation** on 6th October. Please note that delegates are required to book their own accommodation and that payment will be made direct to the delegate and not the local authority.

As the number of passes are limited this offer is restricted to one place per authority and the Association will allocate places on a "first come – first served" basis. However, priority will be given to applicants who are currently studying for an IRRV qualification.

Due to the limited number of passes that are available, applicants will be informed by Wednesday 23rd September whether or not a pass has been granted.

Postal Vote

A ballot paper (which will accompany biographies of all candidates) can be obtained by contacting Gary Watson (<u>Gary.Watson@irrv.org.uk</u>). The completed ballot paper should then then be returned in the pre-paid envelope provided before the closing date.

The closing date for voting is **22nd September 2015 (5.00pm)**. Votes will be then be counted on the **28th September 2015** when postal votes will also be opened. As in previous years, the count will again be independently scrutinised.
