






## Sundry Debt Workshop South Ribble BC, Leyland Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2019

There are two ways in which a member can cast their vote:-

#### Voting Area on the IRRV Web Site

#### Postal Vote

The completed ballot paper should then then be returned in the pre-paid envelope before the closing date.

The Institute's National Council is keen that all eligible members who are entitled to vote, do indeed vote. Closing date for voting is **Sunday**, **22 September 2018 (5.00pm)**.
